UNBC Undergraduate Admission Requirements:

Minimum Requirement:

- Advanced General Certificate of Secondary Education or *Certificat du Cycle Supérieur de l'Enseignement Secondaire*. Minimum of three principal passes in the National Examination with a Grade Point Average of C (Point Value 4) or higher plus a minimum of three subjects in the Ordinary Level National Examination with a Grade Point Average of C (Point Value 4) or higher for general entry.
- Technical Certificate of Secondary Education Level A2 or *Diplôme d'Études Secondaires Techniques A2*/Professional Certificate of Secondary Education Level A2 or *Diplôme d'Études Secondaires Professionnelles A2* GPA of 60% or higher plus a minimum of three subjects in the Ordinary Level National Examination with a Grade Point Average of C (Point Value 4) or higher for general entry.

Transfer Applicants:
