		Carol completed her Advanced Diploma of Orthopaedic and Manipulative Therapy in 1984 and her Clinical Masters of Science in Manipulative Therapy from UWO in 2010. Carol received an Award of Excellence for Clinical Contribution from PABC for her work and teaching related to the cervical spine (2005) and the Golden Hands Award (2015), given to “an exceptional orthopaedic physiotherapist that exemplifies the commitment to our profession in manual therapy, education, mentorship and research” . Carol is a partner at Treloar Physiotherapy Clinic, Vancouver and primarily treats patients with neck pain and is was one of the first physiotherapists to successfully complete the Specialization Program through CPA in the field of musculoskeletal physiotherapy.
