

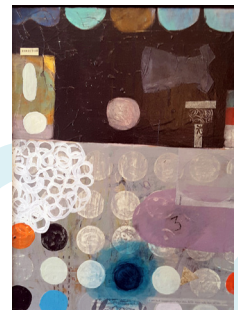
Inspiring Women Among Us
