

Student Employment Opportunities

As a **supplemental instruction leader**, you will support student learning and skill development by conducting supplemental instruction (SI) sessions with students from a particular course. You will be trained in student leadership, group facilitation methods, and learning strategies through initial and ongoing training, offered by certified supplemental instruction supervisors. The ASC offers SI supports for courses in **mathematics, physics, statistics, chemistry, and computer science**.

Examples of typical SI offerings include the following:

MATH 115, 150, 152, 220; PHYS 100, 101, 110, 111; CHEM 100, 101, 201, 203; CPSC 141

Applicants must meet the following requirements and qualifications:

- You have taken and done well in the course (A or higher)
- You are majoring in the course discipline or a related discipline
- You are available 8 hours per week to attend lectures, prepare and facilitate sessions, and participate in training
- You like working with other students and are sensitive to others' learning needs

Scheduling is flexible, dependent on your availability.

Qualified and interested individuals should submit the following via email to asc@unbc.ca:

- A resume including your current contact information, and the name of two faculty members who will act as references
- Your current (unofficial) academic transcript
