Let's Get Active: Active Voice Writing Guide

Use this guide to understand what voice is and how it is used in APA Style. Then practice rewriting sentences from the passive voice to the active voice to help make your writing more clear and concise.

What Is Voice?

In general, *voice* is the tone or attitude conveyed by the writer in a piece of prose. Grammatically, *voice* describes the relationship between a verb and the subject and object associated with it.

What Is Active Voice?

In *active voice*, the subject performs the action expressed by the verb. Therefore, the subject of a sentence is followed by the verb and then the object of the verb.

- **Example:** The teacher gave scratch paper to the students before they took their test.

What Is Passive Voice?

In *passive voice*, the verb expresses the action of the subject. Therefore, the object of the verb is followed by the verb (usually a form of “to be” + past participle + the word “by”) and then the subject.

- **Example:** The scratch paper was given to the students by their teacher before they took their test.

Are Active Voice and Passive Voice Allowed in APA Style?

You can use both the active and the passive voice in your APA Style papers. However, it is common for writers to overuse the passive voice, which can hinder your ability to effectively communicate with your readers and cause unnecessary confusion.

If the subject “teacher” is omitted from the sentence “The scratch paper was given to the students by the teacher before they took their test,” then who gave the scratch paper to the students?

When to Use Active Voice

To create direct, clear, and concise sentences, especially when you are writing about the actions of people, use the active voice.

- **Example:** Health department officials reported data on the spread of the COVID-19 Pirola variant.

When to Use Passive Voice

When it is more important to focus on the recipient of an action and not on who performed the action, such as when describing an experimental setup, use the passive voice.

- **Example:** The soil quality experiment was conducted in three stages—each stage judging the improvement of the soil when infused with a substantial number of unknown organic ingredients.
