COMMUNICATION SKILLS

The ability to communicate ideas clearly and efficiently in a variety of mediums (written, oral, visually and electronically).

PROBLEM SOLVING

Use critical thinking skills to evaluate and solve problems.

Demonstrate the ability to be creative and innovative in identifying solutions.

PERSONAL MANAGEMENT SKILLS

Able to work effectively and independently under deadlines.

Plan, design, and carry out projects from start to finish with well defined objectives and outcomes.

INFORMATION MANAGEMENT

Locate, gather, and organize information using technology and information systems.

Use research skills to access, analyze, and apply knowledge.

TEAMWORK SKILLS

Able to work effectively within a team.

Demonstrate the ability to lead or support a team while monitoring the success of project and identifying ways to improve it.

ETHICS AND VALUES

The ability to take into consideration the costs, benefits, and impact of projects on the individuals involved and society in general.

WHAT CAN YOU DO WITH YOUR DEGREE?

CRIMINOLOGIST

Studies normal social behaviors and how certain factors influence deviation from that norm. They work with and often for law enforcement offices (both local and federal), analyzing the behavior and methods of criminals for a variety of reasons: to increase the chances of criminals being apprehended; to predict patterns and motives for behaviors in certain demographic groups; and to assess the responsiveness of crime to various methods of law enforcement.

HUMAN RESOURCES PROFESSIONAL

Develop, implement, and evaluate human resources and labour relations policies, programs, and procedures. Advises managers and employees on personnel matters.

SCHOOL COUNSELOR

Helps students self understanding, solve school related problems, make personal and career decisions, and select appropriate education programs. Administers and interprets standardized tests, work with school staff, students, and parents to identify and evaluate learning problems.

BEHAVIOUR ANALYST

Analyze the external environment and its effects on human behaviour. Develop task analysis and training programs to assist people in acquiring new behaviours and skills. Work with agencies such as child welfare organizations.

PROBATION / PAROLE OFFICER

Probation Officers monitor the conduct and behaviour of criminal offenders serving probation terms. Parole Officers monitor the reintegration of criminal offenders serving the remainder of sentences while conditionally released into the community on parole.
