COMMUNICATION SKILLS

WHAT CAN YOU DO WITH YOUR DEGREE?

COMMUNITY AND SOCIAL SERVICE WORKER

Coordinates and implements a variety of social assistance programs and community services. Assists clients to deal with personal and social problems. Employed by social service and government agencies, school boards, and correctional services.

WOMEN'S HUMAN RIGHTS RESEARCHER

Works to improve awareness and accountability for human rights violations against women, conducting fact-finding statistics, writing and publicizing reports, and submissions to international bodies.

MULTICULTURALISM EDUCATOR

Implements programs devoted to promote multiculturalism across different communities. Coordinated programs and services for immigrants including promotion of culture, workshops, and consulting services.

WOMEN'S OUTREACH WORKER

Plans and conducts outreach presentations to the public on various issues concerning social, economic, and political concerns.

LABOUR RELATIONS CONSULTANT

Analyze and monitor the staffing policies in order to meet the Employment Standards Act of an Equal Employer. Develops policies that attract qualified women and minority applicants.

PROGRAM COORDINATOR

Supervise short or long-term public education and organize public committees and task forces to conduct research and make public presentations.

SOCIAL SERVICE PLANNER

Develop social programs, social legislation, or proposals based on a demographic, social and economic analysis and the evaluation of pilot projects.
