



More Resilient Communities

Part of **Knowing What We Have and Where We Stand** includes an inventory of government documents, strategies, and plans within a community. Such plans and strategies are valuable tools to support local actions. These tools identify resources and assets, and outline priorities to ensure that development proceeds in a strategic fashion that reflects the vision and aspirations of local residents.

During our visits to OBAC communities, many decision-makers and service providers were interested in knowing how many other communities had completed certain strategies. The *Government Documents Summary Across OBAC Communities* helps leaders to assess their 'preparedness' for transition, as well as to determine needed plans or strategies that can position a community to be 'ready' to pursue new opportunities.

The *Government Documents Summary Across OBAC Communities* is one piece of **Knowing What We Have and Where We Stand**. In turn, Knowing What We Have and Where We Stand is one of three important threads that work together to support local economic transition.

1.0 Introduction

With provincial funding, OBAC was established in 2005 to respond to challenges and opportunities associated with the Mountain Pine Beetle (MPB) epidemic. The goal was to establish a series of strategies and provide direction to diversify economies, enhance resiliency, and ensure the long-term viability of communities within the OBAC region.

The "Community Transition Preparedness Project" is being undertaken through a partnership including OBAC, the Community Development Institute (CDI) at UNBC, and the Community Transition Board of the BC Ministry of Community Services. The 'location' of the project includes the areas and communities covered by OBAC within the Fraser-Fort George Regional District and the Bulkley-Nechako Regional District. In terms of population, the 2006 census recorded a population of 101,881 for the Fraser-Fort George Regional District, and 44,147 for the Bulkley-Nechako Regional District. This area is most significantly impacted by the MPB epidemic.

There are three pieces to the "Community Transition Preparedness Project". First, an inventory of services and networks was completed in each community to assess their 'readiness' to embark on transition processes. The second involves reviewing this gap analysis with OBAC communities. The final piece entails refining the "economic transition toolkit" that the CDI designed to help rural and small towns places prepare for challenges and change.

The purpose of this study is to understand the breadth of plans and documents that may exist in a community. In turn, plans and documents can serve as valuable tools in a community's efforts to mobilize resources and assets, as well as to take advantage of opportunities during economic transition processes.

2.0 Key Findings

The data for this report was collected through community visits in May and June 2008, along with follow up phone calls in July. An inventory of plans and documents published in each surveyed OBAC community help to assess their abilities to embark on transition planning processes. Where applicable, this report also indicates any reports or studies that are "in progress".

Financial planning documents are kept up-to-date in surveyed OBAC communities. In particular, all municipalities have published five year financial plans, annual financial reports, and official community plans. Many of these are available online. However, few municipalities have produced environmental strategies, such as air and water quality / protection plans. These topics are increasingly important to economic development. None of the communities have pest management or beautification plans. Most, however, have completed community forest management plans and open burning bylaws. Almost half of the communities have completed an energy plan, and an additional two communities are in the process of completing their own energy plans. Again, energy is an increasingly important aspect of economic development work.

Roughly half of the communities have economic plans and studies, as well as tourism strategies. Many of these economic planning documents are available online. Unfortunately, few have marketing plans to compliment them. Additionally, fewer communities have published economic diversification plans or economic leakage studies, which are relevant to transition efforts.

Many of the surveyed municipalities have documents relating to service planning. These are especially important since services are crucial to a community's ability to adapt to economic transition. Specifically, most have solid waste management and snow removal plans. There are no current recycling plans in communities, although two are in the process of formalizing recycling documents.

Few of the surveyed communities have published plans related to social infrastructure. In particular, few have developed youth initiatives, senior citizen plans, or health services plans. Such strategies would provide a useful foundation for planning to meet the needs of an aging population around the north, to address the needs of a growing aboriginal youth population, and to mitigate factors leading to the youth out-migration. Almost none have completed social plans, social asset maps, homeless or poverty studies, or documents related to social housing. Such plans are important to help communities to prepare to meet the needs and stresses of laid-off workers and their families, as well as to address persistent poverty issues in these communities. The Cariboo-Chilcotin Beetle Action Coalition (C-CBAC) has made social infrastructure and transition planning a high priority in its work. Affordable rental accommodations and emergency shelters are absent in many of these communities. Furthermore, as many of these towns were designed to attract a young labour force to work in industry, few are equipped with retirement facilities and services to meet the needs of seniors. Moreover, none of the communities have completed a heritage plan that can compliment tourism and cultural

strategies. Despite the lack of documents addressing social service planning and infrastructure, all have emergency preparedness plans for fire, flood, earthquake and power loss.

The surveyed OBAC municipalities currently have a wide range of important plans and policies to support economic transition processes. Such government documents are essential to mobilize local resources that enable communities to respond to new employment and service opportunities associated with economic transition.

3.0 Policy Recommendations

While most of the surveyed communities have made impressive efforts to produce a wide array of strategic plans, many need to concentrate on developing strategies to address key issues, such as economic diversification, social infrastructure, and marketing. This section highlights policy recommendations to assist communities in the OBAC region to continue to develop relevant plans and strategies to support community development.

Human Resource Networks

- Support innovative regional human resources initiatives, such as sharing key personnel across multiple communities.
- Support and promote information sharing mechanisms to enable places with limited human and fiscal resources to draft policies and plans.

While the majority of the surveyed OBAC communities remarked that they exchange information with each other regarding by-laws and policies, it is important to realize that some municipalities have limited human and fiscal resources. Communities may want to explore creative way of addressing staffing issues. For example, one community was able to draw upon the expertise of engineering staff from another municipality to assist in local infrastructure development. Others regularly visit CivicInfo BC (www.civicinfo.bc.ca) to view bylaws and regulations drafted in other places.

Developing Best Practices

- Promote better practices for interacting with consultants in developing various types of plans.
- Develop how-to guidelines for government documents and plans.

Several communities have published key documents addressing environmental and other concerns. However, few have addressed the issues of air and water quality, civic beautification, energy, or pest management. Although many have asserted that they would like to complete such plans, they cite a lack of resources and issues with consultants as reasons why these initiatives are not completed. For example, one participant noted that consultants do not properly explain the financial ramifications of infrastructure plans. By comparison, ministry staff were commended for their ability to outline the health, environmental, and financial issues associated with such initiatives. The development of guidelines to outline key steps, issues, and government personnel that need to be contacted in pursuing these initiatives would be useful to overcome some of these challenges.

Accessibility

- Post government documents and plans on municipal websites.
- Support ongoing training of Internet skills amongst municipal staff.

Given that many communities prefer contacting each other to share information about developing bylaws and plans, it is important for municipalities to offer easier access to

documents online. Additional training may be required to ensure that municipal staff have sufficient Internet skills to fulfill these needs.
