Additional Information

- Incomplete registration forms will not be accepted. All fields are required, unless otherwise indicated.
- If you are a sponsored student, Continuing Studies must confirm your sponsorship before you will be registered.
- In face to face courses or virtual courses, a minimum number of registrations must be received by the posted registration deadline. If sufficient registration is not met by this date, the course may be cancelled.
- You must complete each module with a minimum grade of C- in order to continue to the next module. If the minimum requirement is not met, and you have paid for more than one module upfront, you will be withdrawn from the remaining modules and a refund will be issued in the same form as it was received.
