

Wildlife Dangerous Tree Assessor Certificate Exam Challenge Procedure

People interested in Challenging a Wildlife Dangerous Tree Assessor Module Exam must meet the following criteria:

- 1. Hold a valid Certification and be an active Wildlife Dangerous Tree Assessor as part of their current employment; and,
- 2. Have taken at least one re-certification course (in the same module) subsequent to their first certification course; and.
- 3. Provide documented proof of Wildlife Dangerous Tree Assessing experience over the last two years (i.e. a letter from a contractor/employer or contract invoice; and,
- 4. Provide a sample copy of a completed set of FS502 field cards from a recent project; and,
- 5. Provide an existing Wildlife Dangerous Tree certification number; and once approved to Challenge,
- 6. Register and pre-pay by phone (250-960-5980) for a suitable Exam Challenge module; and,
- 7. Complete the written and oral field exam on Day 2 of the course.

*All required documentation must be submitted to <u>cstudies@unbc.ca</u> for a Challenge consideration prior to moving onto Step #6.

Note: A maximum of two Challenge participants will be accepted per public delivery.
