



# MOVE IN CHECKLIST

Moving into residence is an exciting time, but it can also be difficult. Here's a list of things that we suggest you bring with you on move in day — and things you definitely shouldn't! Please bring one vehicle only! What you can't fit in one vehicle likely won't fit in your room!

## WHAT TO BRING



### BEDROOM

- ⇒ Bed Linens (Twin Size)
- ⇒ Pillows and Pillow Covers
- ⇒ Foam Top
- ⇒ Fall & Winter Clothing
- ⇒ Pictures and Posters
- ⇒ Alarm Clock

Note: Your residence bed is provided



### SUITE KITCHENETTE

During the academic year, you may require some of the food and prep/cooking items. Please note all kitchen appliances must be CSA approved and must not have an open heat element.

- ⇒ Cookware
- ⇒ Cutlery
- ⇒ Dishes
- ⇒ Pots/Pans
- ⇒ Toaster Oven
- ⇒ Coffee Pot / Tea Kettle
- ⇒ Dishtowels, Dish Soap



### WASHROOM (SHARED WITH ROOMMATES)

- ⇒ Shower Curtain
- ⇒ Personal Toiletries (i.e. Toothpaste, Shampoo, Conditioner, Makeup, Medication etc.)
- ⇒ Cleaning Supplies
- ⇒ Toilet Paper



Wait until after you have moved in before purchasing any items that can be shared. UNBC is located within close distances to major retail stores (i.e. Walmart).



### DAY TO DAY

- ⇒ Clothes Hangers
- ⇒ Clothing
- ⇒ Reusable Coffee/Tea/Water Bottle
- ⇒ Toiletries
- ⇒ Towels



### MISCELLANEOUS

- ⇒ Renters Insurance
- ⇒ Laundry Basket , Liquid Laundry Detergent, & Dryer Sheets
- ⇒ Loonies and Quarters—Laundry
- ⇒ Extension Cord for Vehicle Block Heaters
- ⇒ Shovel—Parking Space
- ⇒ Health Card & Other ID
- ⇒ First Aid Kit
- ⇒ Cleaning Supplies (Broom, Mop, Bucket, Vacuum)
- ⇒ Small Fan

### DECORATING YOUR SUITE

- ◇ Nothing is to be affixed to your window to deface or compromise the general esthetics of the outside of the building
- ◇ There is a zero tolerance policy for any items affixed to the walls within suites including common areas and individual bedrooms using wall damaging materials. You may use painters tape or sticky tack.
- ◇ Any decorations used in your suite should be fire retardant or flame proof
- ◇ Strings of indoor lights should not be in direct contact with any flammable materials and should not be left on while the room is unattended
- ◇ Real Christmas trees are prohibited due to fire regulations.



## WHAT NOT TO BRING

- ⇒ Hot Plates, Deep Fryer, Cooking Appliances with an Open Heat Element
- ⇒ Bed Risers
- ⇒ Halogen Lamps, Candles, or Incense
- ⇒ Pets (excluding Fish)
- ⇒ Subwoofers
- ⇒ Anything that can alter the condition of your room
- ⇒ Large Volume Alcohol Containers (Mini-Kegs, Kegs, Bubbas)
- ⇒ Funnels, Beer Pong Tables, other High Risk Drinking Paraphernalia
- ⇒ Pipes, Hookahs, Bongs, Rolling Paper, Other Smoking Paraphernalia
