### **Natural Sciences and Engineering Grants**

- NSERC Alliance Advantage Grants encourage university researchers to collaborate with partner organizations, which can be from the private, public or not-for-profit sectors. Alliance Advantage grants (formerly Alliance cost-sharing option 1) are for partner-driven projects. They fund projects focused on the partners' goals, with at least one partner sharing in the costs of research.

  Application deadline: Continuous Intake
- <u>NSERC Alliance Society Grants</u> encourage university researchers to collaborate with partner organizations, which can be from the private, public or not-for-profit sectors. Alliance Society grants (formerly Alliance cost-sharing option 2) fund projects with societal impact as the main driver.

• NSERC Alliance International Grants provide support for researchers in Canada to work with leading international researchers from the academic sector, and to establish and grow international research collaborations and projects that have a high potential for impact in NSE disciplines.

NSERC Collaborative Research and Training Experience (CREATE) program supports the training and mentoring of teams of highly qualified students and postdoctoral fellows from Canada and abroad through the development of innovative training programs

## Other Grants and Scholarships

- Pacific Institute for Climate Solutions Wildfire Resilience Research Contribution Program
   allows research teams at PICS universities to apply for a portion of the matching funding required for
   the Natural Resources Canada Build and Mobilize Foundational Wildland Fire Knowledge Program (described below).
   Letter of intent deadline: April 18, 2024
- Natural Resources Canada Build and Mobilize Foundational Wildland Fire Knowledge Program aims to address gaps in foundational knowledge by developing and evaluating wildland fire risk assessment and risk mitigation strategies and technologies that support Indigenous peoples, local and provincial/territorial governments and fire management agencies to reduce wildfire risk in the face of a changing climate. Note: matching funding can be applied for from the PICS Wildfire Resilience Research Contribution Program (described above).
- NFRF 2024 NordForsk-led International Joint Initiative on Sustainable Development of the Arctic represents a collaboration among research funders from Canada, Denmark, the Faroe Islands, Finland, Greenland, Iceland, Norway, Sweden and the United States. Through interdisciplinary research projects that include Indigenous perspectives, this call will leverage expertise across Arctic countries to explore approaches to sustainable development in the Arctic.

National Science Foundation Global Centres: Bioeconomy aims to encourage and support international, interdisciplinary collaborative research centres that will develop use-inspired research to address global challenges through the bioeconomy. Applicants to this initiative must collaborate with at least one US-based researcher who meets the NSF eligibility requirements.

## **Internal Grants**

• Research Strategic Initiatives Grants (RSIG) welcome requests from all UNBC faculty, research organizations, graduate and undergraduate student groups engaged in research. Funds are directed toward research activities for which other sources of funding are not available.

There are four application deadlines per year: January 1, April 1, July 1, and October 1

• <u>BC Real Estate Foundation Partnering Fund</u> aims to assist faculty and students in obtaining and leveraging funding for research and educational programs that speak to the goals of the Foundation Partnering Fund.

Application deadline: April 15, 2024

• Research Data Center (RDC) Research Awards support the development and implementation of research projects conducted in the RDC. Note that researchers must set up a consultation with the RDC at least one week prior to the application deadline.

Application deadline: April 19, 2024

Collaboration for Health Research in Northern BC Project Grants aim to enable 3 or more collaborators from UNBC, Northern Health, and the Provincial Health Services Authority to work in partnership and initiate new research projects that focus on improving (i) the quality of health services and (ii) the health of the population in northern BC.

# Research Contracts and Agreements: What do researchers need to do to get the process started?

Note: Research Agreements include funding agreements, contribution agreements, transfer agreements, service (consulting) agreements, research services contracts, as well as non-disclosure agreements, material transfer, data use, research collaborations, community research agreements, intellectual property, MOU's and waivers.

- ♦ To request the preparation or review of a research agreement, complete and submit a Romeo file for the proposed research project. If the proposed project does not require the submission of a pre-award funding proposal, you will need to complete and attach the Request for Research Agreement Form, which can be found on the <u>UNBC Romeo support page</u>.
- Once received in the Office of Research and Innovation, the appropriate Research Project Officer will review the file and will submit the Romeo file for institutional approval. Once approved, the Research Project Officer will notify you and the Research Contract Coordinator that the file is ready for further processing. The Research Contract Coordinator will then begin the process of drafting/reviewing the research agreement.
