The waterfront is one of the focal points of Camp Goodtimes and lifeguards are required to execute all water programming including swimming lessons, boating, and special event programming at the dock.

#### Job Responsibilities

- Facilitate all water based programming including swimming lessons, canoeing, kayaking, water based games
- Flexibility in work tasks, ability to help out in other area of camp if needed
- Help facilitate evening and all-camp programs when waterfront is closed

- Experience in teaching swimming and canoeing skills
- Ability to work independently and as a team
- Confident being in front of large groups
