Health Sciences Grants Update

- **MSFHR Scholar Program** supports early-career health researchers who are building leading-edge health research programs, training the next generation of scientists, and expanding their potential to make significant contributions to their field.
Letter of Intent deadline: February 8, 2021 Full application deadline: March 22, 2021
- **MSFHR Research Trainee Award** supports outstanding early career researchers from across BC who have recently completed a PhD, or who are a health professional eligible for a research fellowship program.
Letter of Intent deadline: February 8, 2021 Full application deadline: March 29, 2021
- **MHRC COVID-19 Child, Youth & Family Mental Health Impact Grant** will support research that advances the understanding of the impact of COVID-19 on the mental health of families and caregivers who raise children and youth with special needs in British Columbia, and the identification of approaches to mitigate these impacts.
Application deadline: February 28, 2021
- **CIHR Project Grants** support projects or programs of research proposed and conducted by individual researchers or groups of researchers in all areas of health.
Registration deadline: March 4, 2021 Full application deadline: April 1, 2021
